For this topic, they are planning to track:  1. Volume of oil spilled to surface waters from all sources — to better understand overall success in preventing and/or mitigating oil spills  2. Estimated total monetary damage of spilled oil (via natural resource damage assessments) — to better understand the scope of damages through the spill of oil, via financial estimates  3.
